ARTICLE I
Decreasing Members

§ 115-1. Findings.

The Village of Lyndon Station is a Village incorporated under the general laws of the State of Wisconsin and is governed by a Board consisting of five Trustees including the Village President.

§ 115-2. Authority; membership decreased; elections.

Pursuant to § 61.20(4), Wis. Stats., the Village Board of the Village of Lyndon Station hereby decreases the number of Trustees of said Village of Lyndon Station to a total of three Trustees including the Village President effective as follows: the spring election of 1973 shall be held for the purpose of filling two vacancies, which include candidates to fill the office of Village President and one Trustee; the spring election of 1974 shall be held to fill the office of the other Trustee and those individuals elected shall hold office for two years; thereafter election shall be held annually and in the even-numbered years one Trustee shall be elected and in the odd-numbered years the President and one Trustee shall be elected.

§ 115-3. Effect on existing office holders.

This article shall not affect the term of office of Trustees elected prior to the adoption of such article authorizing the aforementioned changes.
