

Village Ordinance 368-5. Operation limitations for All-Terrain Vehicles.

It shall be unlawful to operate an all-terrain vehicle pursuant to § 368-4 of this chapter unless the operator thereof meets all of the following qualifications:

- A. The operator shall meet all age requirements as set by Wisconsin Statutes.
- B. All-terrain vehicles shall be operated with the headlights and taillights on at all times while operated in the Village.
- C. All-terrain vehicles shall not exceed 10 miles per hour within the Village limits.
- D. All-terrain vehicles shall not be operated between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. within the Village limits of Lyndon Station.
- E. It shall be unlawful for any all-terrain vehicle to cross any intersection within the Village of Lyndon Station without first stopping and thereafter proceeding with caution only when the street to be crossed is clear of traffic.
- F. All-terrain vehicles operated on Village streets shall operate in single file and as close to the right-hand side of the street as possible.
- G. All-terrain vehicles shall yield the right-of-way to all other motor vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians in every instance.
- H. All-terrain vehicle owners and/or operators shall assume full liability.
- I. No person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle on any private property not owned or controlled by himself without the express consent or permission of the landowner.

Village Ordinance 368-6. Operation limitations for Light Utility Vehicles.

- A. The operator must possess a valid motor vehicle operator license.
- B. The number of passengers carried on a side-by-side light utility vehicle shall be limited by the number of manufacturer seat belts.
- C. The driver and passengers of a light utility vehicle must wear seat belts at all times.
- D. The driver and passengers of a light utility vehicle shall keep their hands, arms, feet and legs inside the vehicle at all times during operation.
- E. The driver of a light utility vehicle shall obey all signs, gates and barriers and posted roadway speed limits.
- F. For the purpose of this chapter a light utility vehicle will be considered an all-terrain vehicle and all ordinances and laws applicable to all-terrain vehicles apply to light utility vehicles.

Village Ordinance 369 Operation limitations for Golf Carts.

It shall be unlawful to operate a golf carts pursuant to this chapter unless the operator thereof meets all of the following qualifications:

- A. The operator shall meet all age requirements as set by Wisconsin Statutes.
- B. Golf Carts shall be operated with the headlights and taillights on at all times while operated in the Village.
- C. Golf Carts shall not exceed 10 miles per hour within the Village limits.
- D. Golf Carts shall not be operated between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. Within the Village limits of Lyndon Station.
- E. It shall be unlawful for any Golf Cart to cross any intersection within the Village of Lyndon Station without first stopping and thereafter proceeding with caution only when the street to be crossed is clear of traffic.
- F. Golf Carts operated on Village streets shall operate in single file and as close to the right-hand side of the street as possible.
- G. Golf Carts shall yield the right-of-way to all other motor vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians in every instance.
- H. Golf Cart owners and/or operators shall assume full liability.
- I. No person shall operate an golf cart on any private property not owned or controlled by himself without the express consent or permission of the landowner.
